

## **Code Breaker**

These exercises help practise non-verbal reasoning skills by challenging the student to carefully look at the properties of each box in terms of shape types, numbers, sizes, shading, and locations.


**1** Look at the examples below and determine the code for the final shape.

- 4) Remember some shapes or symbols may not always be part of the code




